#### Notes

- The above Audited Financial Results for the quarter and year ended 31/03/2020, have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and taken on record and approved by the board of Directors of the Company at their meeting held on 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2020. The Statutory Auditors have conducted the audit of the financial statements and have expressed an unqualified report on these financial results.
- 2. The Company has only one reportable business segment i.e., Paper. Accordingly, separate segment information is not applicable.
- 3. The financial results have been prepared in accordance with the Indian Accounting Standards (IND AS) specified in the companies (Indian accounting audit standard Rules, 2015 (as amended) under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 (the "accounting principles generally accepted in India")
- 4. The figures of quarter ended March 31, 2020 and March 31, 2019are balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of full financial year and the published year to date figures upto December 31, 2019, and Dec 31, 2018 being the end of the third quarter of the financial year which was subjected to limited review.
- 5. Figures of the previous quarter/periods have been re-arranged, wherever necessary.
- 6. Due to outbreak of COVID-19 globally and in India, the company is sensitive about the impact of the Pandemic, not only on the human life but on businesses and industrial activity across the globe, which will be realized and ascertained only over next few months. The company has been monitoring the situation closely and has taken proactive measures to comply with various directions / regulations / guidelines issued by Government and local bodies to ensure safety of employees in its office. The liquidity and profitability of the Company has affected as due to nationwide lockdown announced by Government, there was no volume of business and cash flows from sales and marketing activities. As our company deals in marketing of paper and paper products, the cash flow activities are more concerned. As the COVID19 pandemic is still evolving and the virus is still spreading in various parts of India, the future impact of the pandemic on the overall operations and financials of the Company cannot be assessed with certainty.
- 7. There is regrouping/reclassification of Other Income and Employee Benefit expenses in the current quarter.

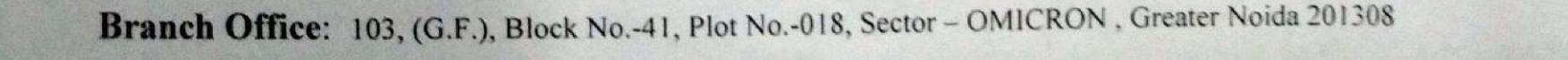
In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us these standalone financial results:

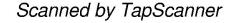
- i. are presented in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations in this regard; and

## Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Standalone Financial Results

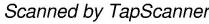
