Report on the audit of the Standalone Financial Results

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying standalone quarterly financial results of **M/s Neeraj Paper Marketing Limited** (the company) for the quarter ended **31st March 2023** and the year to date results for the period from **01st April 2022 to 31st March 2023**, attached herewith, being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulations").

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us these standalone financial results:

Our conclusions are based on the audit evidence obtained up to the date of our auditor's report. However, future events or conditions may cause the Company to cease to continue as a going concern.

• Evaluate the overall presentation, structure and content of the standalone financial results, including the disclosures, and whether the financial results represent the underlying transactions and events in a manner that achieves fair presentation.
