Report on the audit of the Standalone Financial Results

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying standalone quarterly financial results of Neeraj Paper Marketing Limited for the quarter ended 31st March 2024 and the year to date results for the period from 01st April 2023 to 31st March 2024, attached herewith, being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulations").

ii. give a true and fair view in conformity with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the applicable accounting standards and other accounting principles generally accepted in India of the net profit and other comprehensive income and other financial information for the quarter ended 31st March 2024as well as the year to date standalone annual financial results for the period from 01st April 2023to 31st March 2024.



Basis for Opinion
